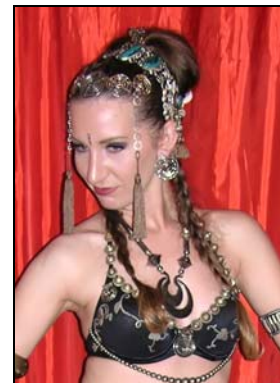

Silvia feels honored and blessed to be now part of the premiere Houston Tribal performance troupe Urban Gypsy. Silvia teaches both Tribal and Egyptian style belly dance in Houston.

Lori Webb discovered tribal fusion belly dance in 2005 during a mindful search to fill a creative and physical void. Most of all, she loves the camaraderie she's established with her fellow dance mates. She is currently in private study with Silvia Salamanca of Mallorca, Spain and is training at Zahira Noor Studios with her up and coming troupe Tribe Zahira, also directed by Silvia.

In 1979 he was reunited with his father Bucky Meadows - legendary pianist and guitarist most noted for his work with Willie Nelson. Randy began his career in music by organizing the band "Tumbleweed Connection." Randy then became the lead singer of the "Straight Up Band", a popular Houston based group that performed at nightclubs, festivals, hotels and weddings. Randy wrote, recorded and produced his first album, You've Been Kind of Cold. Soon after, he co-produced The Moving Men, an album with other talented Houston artists and musicians. He has recently released a new album Family Portrait which includes guest appearances by Willie Nelson and legendary musician Bucky Meadows.
